Recognition that taking on responsibility for all L5 appointments (when previously Southern Federation has only managed c.20 Dev'mt Squad appointments per season) would be: 1. A significant increase in S/Fed Appointments workload	

 A significant change in purpose of S/Fed (from one <u>solely</u> focusing on MO development pathway) Re: 1. SB has indicated he would be willing to take on the L5 Appointments role, if asked - ideally suited, given his deep knowledge of the Appointments processes & systems employed (ie. WTR), experience & understanding of the requirements of refereeing at L5 and above, and his extensive network of contacts in neighbouring Federations (to facilitate L5 exchanges between Feds, for independent observation of MOs and to cover potential MO shortages) Question raised re: potential need for backfill/additional in-county 'BAU' Appointments support for SB, if additional L5 S/Fed workload taken on – SB believes things should be manageable but will shout if reality proves different.
